Your curriculum

The Center for Project Innovation endorses project management courses that consistently demonstrate outcomes aligned to proven project management methodologies, industry standards and good practice.

Courses must run for a minimum of 25 teaching contact hours and include a formal knowledge assessment.

Note that courses must explicitly educate on an aspect or all of 'project management'. Academic completion of a workplace or industry project and/or general management studies are not eligible for endorsement.

Any student who successfully graduates from an endorsed course is immediately eligible to be admitted to the Institute as **Certified Project Officer (CPO)** at a significant discount to the price advertised on our websites.

This fee can be paid directly by the student or charged back to the course provider.

Students can also go on to receive a discount on higher-level certifications, with an equivalent credit applied to the course provider's account for each redemption. The University of Tasmania's ZAA233 Managing Projects and ZAS223 Managing Projects, People & Yourself are elective units of study in their popular Associate and Bachelor's degrees in Business.

Each unit is endorsed by the Center for Project Innovation and CPO certification is included in the students' tuition fee.

Over 80% of graduates go on to formally certify with the Center and many are now enjoying successful careers at senior levels with leading employers across Australia.



Our curriculum

The Bahrain Society of Engineers have secured funding from the Ministry of Labour and Social Affairs to deliver the ARC program to graduate engineers and related industry para-professionals.

Nearly 200 students progressed through the program in 2023 with an outstanding level of student and employer satisfaction.





The Center for Project Innovation's Advanced Recognition and Certification (ARC) workshop is a wholly interactive experience in which participants initiate, plan, deliver and close an actual project.

Over 12 face-to-face or online collaborative sessions, expert facilitators leverage students' latent project experience to connect a common frame of reference, common purpose and common-sense approach to the cohesive delivery and oversight of professional and personal projects.

Accredited education partners have access to the complete digital library of ARC resources, including PowerPoint presentations, interactive assessment pdfs and student handouts.

These resources are fully customizable and editable for local industry, context or language delivery.

It is a condition of accreditation that education partners only use Certified Project Trainers in the delivery of the ARC program.

ARC graduates are immediately eligible to be admitted to the Center at a Certification level commensurate with their professional experience.

Longer programs, including academic unit, major or degree programs, are also available upon request.
